**LS 301**, prompted by Don Armstrong; LS 302, instrumental (Glise a Sherbrooke)

**Formation**: Contra lines. 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, etc., couples active and crossed over. This dance has a double progression so each set should have an even number of couples. The crossovers at the head and foot of the set are automatic and need not be called.

## To prompt this dance:

```
Intro - - - , EVERYBODY FORWARD AND BACK,
```

1-8---, -- CORNER SWING,

9-16 - - - - , PUT HER ON THE RIGHT GO DOWN IN FOURS,

17-24 - - - WHEEL TURN, - - COME BACK TO PLACE,

25-32 - - BEND THE LINE, - - LADIES CHAIN,

33-40 - - - , - - CHAIN THEM BACK,

41-48 - - - - , ALL PASS THRU AND TURN ALONE,

49-56 - - - - , WITH THE LADY <u>ON THE RIGHT PROMENADE</u> HOME,

As the dancers learn the figure, less prompting is necessary.

## For example:

```
57-64 - - - , - - FORWARD AND BACK,
```

1-8----, -- CORNER SWING,

9-16 - - - , - - FOURS DOWN,

17-24 - - - WHEEL, - - - BACK,

25-32 - - - BEND IT, - - - CHAIN

33-40 - - - - , - - - BACK,

41-48 - - - - , - - ALL PASS THRU,

49-56 - - - - , WITH THE LADY ON THE RIGHT PROMENADE
