Come back home, twirl your own, promenade

As you promenade with me, how I'm hoping there will be,

Dance Pattern:

Heads (sides) to the middle, a right and left through and wheel 'em full around

All promenade keep on walkin' 'round the town

Heads (sides) wheel around and do-sa-do, go back to back you know

Make that ocean wave and rock it up and back – go right and left through

Turn your girl, pass on through, bend the line

Trail on through, corners swing, oh so fine

Promenade so merrily, when the moon shines down you'll see
